**T**hank you for continuing to pray for CPAS. Your support not only means a lot to us, but is also I believe the means by which the power of God is apprehended in our work and ministry. I was recently reminded of several sayings that capture a biblical understanding of the role of prayer. Let me offer them to you as an encouragement to continue in your prayers for CPAS.

## 'strike the mark'

The first of these was 'what goes up, comes down'.

In Revelation 8

we read of the prayers of the saints rising to heaven like incense and then being returned to earth in sovereign power. This image was the inspiration behind the Moravian prayer commitment of 1727 which lasted for over 100 years. It assures us that God hears and responds to our prayers.

'Small keys unlock big doors' is a very different saying but equally instructive for the praying life. The story is told that during one of Charles Finney's visits to the UK he held a series of meetings in Bolton that were wonderfully fruitful in the number of conversions. What intrigued some onlookers was the role of his two travelling companions, who it appeared, never went to any of the evangelistic meetings. It transpired that they locked themselves away in a small room whenever Finney was preaching to pray throughout the meeting. The same dynamic is evident in the role of sisters Peggy

and Christine Smith in the Hebridean revival who (both in their 80s) are often attributed with praying-in the revival of 1948-52.

These saints of former times were not big in the eyes of the world – but their prayers released enormous blessing from heaven. Small keys unlock big doors.

In Isaiah 59:16 we find a third saying that teaches us concerning the role of prayer. God's lament through the prophet is that there is no one to 'strike the mark' (the literal translation of the Hebraic word used). In other words, prayer in some way paints the target – and God is concerned because no one can be found to do so. Of course, God does not need us to tell him where his sovereign power should be released. God does not need our directions or our assessment of the need. But it appears that he chooses to work in this way – he, in his sovereign power, asks us to engage with his saving purposes.

These sayings assure us that our prayers matter to God and that he is longing for us to pursue him so that men, women and children should come to faith in Christ.

Please continue to support us in your prayers – and use this diary to inform, direct and shape those prayers.

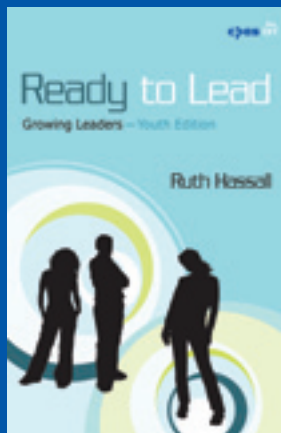

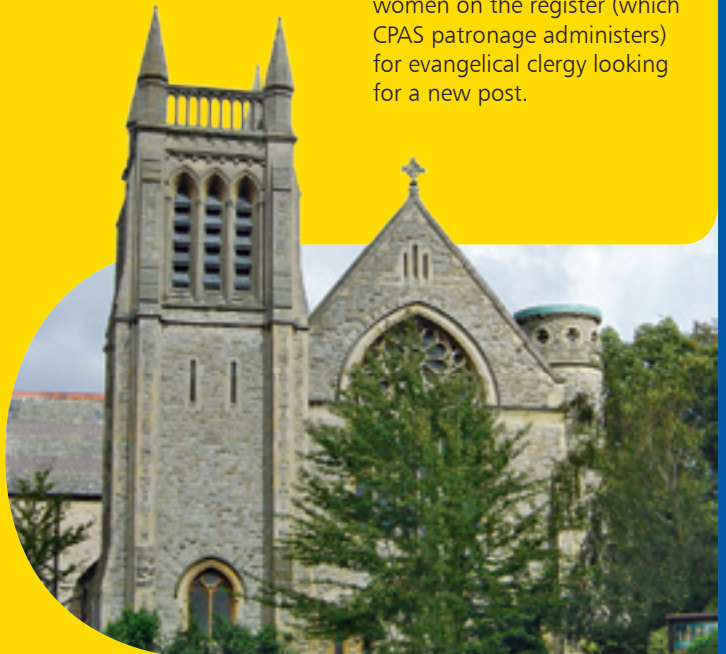
