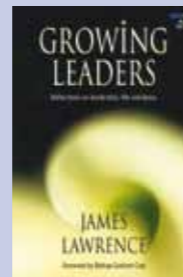
Growing Leaders for growing churches

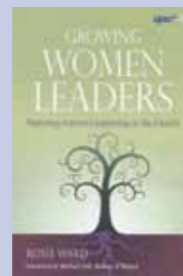
Growing Leaders
