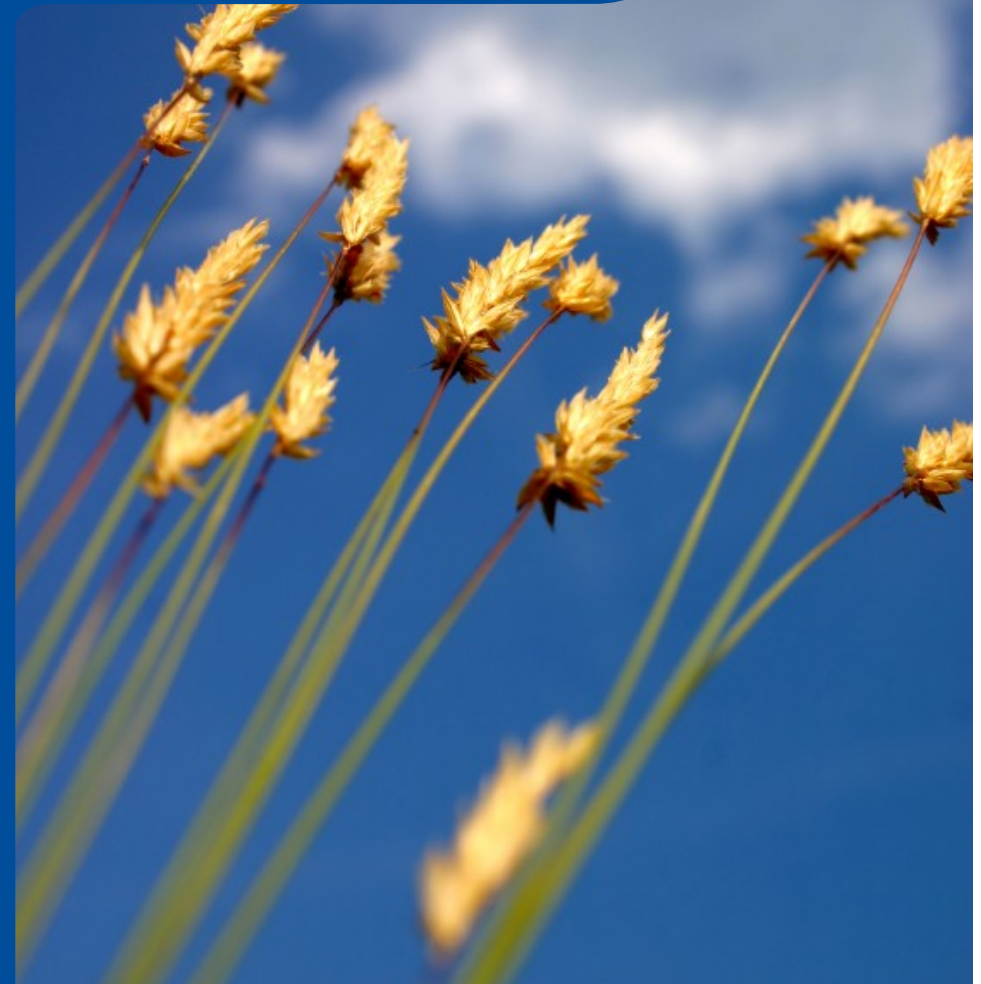

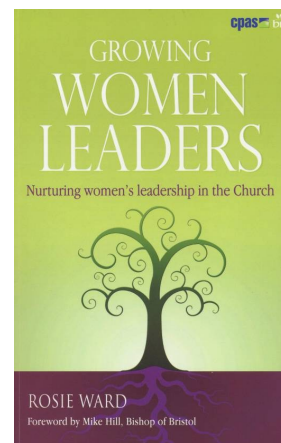
## Growing Women Leaders
