Making Mission Possible across the country

A new initiative of leadership development events is taking place this autumn for volunteer and paid youth workers across the country. CPAS, the Anglican evangelical mission agency and long-term contributor to youth ministry, is working in partnership with churches, deaneries and dioceses on *Making Mission Possible* to help develop youth leaders for mission.

'Growing young people in a church' and 'Developing a youth strategy' are just two of the event themes covered by *Making Mission Possible* which have been designed specifically for those involved in youth ministry.

Other events include *Lifecall*, designed to help 16-25s explore God's call on their lives, and *Growing Leaders – Youth Edition* training days.

The programme also includes a number of events suitable for a wide range of church leaders, including 'Building and maintaining teams in local churches' and 'Mission-shaped Leadership'.

The Rev John Dunnett, general director of CPAS, said: '*Making Mission Possible* is an exciting initiative designed to make a big impact on missional leadership development in the Church today. My prayer is that it will help equip leaders of all ages to enable their local church to be more effective in bringing men, women and children to Christ.'
