This rural benefice (population c. 3,500) is in Northamptonshire but close to the borders with Leicestershire and Warwickshire. The villages are set in the valley at the edge of the beautiful rolling Northamptonshire uplands and the Rectory is situated in Crick. Communication links are good: the M1, M6, A5 and A14 give road access to all corners of the country. There is easy rail travel to London and Birmingham.
