**LEADING MEETINGS**

This session considers how meetings can contribute effectively to ministry and mission. It explores the skills needed for leading effective meetings and considers the practicalities of what makes a good meeting. It includes: setting vision, establishing boundaries, drafting agendas, preparing papers and contentious discussions.

**SERVANTS AND STEWARDS/LEADERSHIP COURSE**

Being a church leader is an exciting, complex and changing role. This year long course seeks to enable effective missional leadership for churches. It offers insights and tools on the inner and outer life of the leader.

**LEADING WELL COURSE**

Leading well as an incumbent is both stimulating and demanding, particularly during the early years of an incumbency. This course is aimed primarily at those who want to grow in their core leadership skills.

**LEADERSHIP IN MISSION**

A five sessions course for theological students, covering topics ranging from the biblical basis for leadership, collaborative leadership, leadership and power, self leadership, missional leadership and culture change.

**ARROW LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME**

Over 18 months, Arrow creates transformative experiences to engage and stretch leaders, aged 25–40, for resilience in Christian ministry. Focusing on areas such as character, self-care, the challenges of leadership, spiritual disciplines, personal management, vision and mission, managing conflict and communication.

**OVERSIGHT MINISTRY**

Many dioceses appoint incumbents in roles overseeing multiple churches and benefices across multiple locations. This new course supports incumbents as they transition to this complex missional role.

**RESILIENCE/DEVELOPING RESILIENCE**

Building on research done across churches into resilience and well-being, this event offers practical tools for church leaders to reflect on their own resilience, and explore how to develop resilience without adding extra pressure to their already pressured lives.

**LEADERSHIP IN VISION/ LEADING INTO VISION**

Leadership is about going somewhere, and for church leaders it is helping a church to discern God's direction for the future. The day explores a variety of ways of doing this and the key things a leader brings to the process.

**PURPOSEFUL PLANNING**

Exploring key steps in purposeful planning, considering how to work out what leaders need to do and what others can do, and looking at some simple project planning tools.

**PCC TONIGHT**

An online event to clarify the purpose and place of PCCs, to explore some common dysfunctions, and to introduce material that can be used to shape its life.

**LEADING EVANGELISM LEARNING HUB**

Facilitated by CPAS and in collaboration with the diocese, the church leader and a small team explore how to develop their evangelism ministry appropriately for their context. This is done over four terms alongside other churches on the same journey.

**CLERGY MINISTERIAL DEVELOPMENT (CMD)**

Dioceses gather their clergy to offer opportunities for development and these days are called CMD days. CPAS can be asked to deliver training on these days.

**HOW TO LEAD WELL WITH OTHERS**

Leadership is best done as a communal enterprise. But that isn't always easy. How do we tackle the challenges and lean into the blessings of leading well with others?

**ORDERLINESS**

Exploring how leaders can order their time, energy, and attention through prayerful discernment and practical tools to make wise decisions, and how to order your life around those decisions.

**MOVING ON**

For clergy seeking a new post. This online, forum-style, event offers clergy insights into the tricky subject of moving jobs.
