# Leadership

This exciting summer term has seen our team deliver 66 events between April and July. Thanks to your support, a major focus has been training and journeying with ministers with significant oversight responsibility as they lead multiple churches across different communities.

Matt completed a year-long Oversight Ministers course with the Diocese of Worcester, while Sarah led Oversight sessions in Truro and Derby.

One participant shared,

Additional highlights from this term include:

- Over 100 people attended our online PCC Tonight event, engaging in vital conversations around parish leadership.
- The Arrow Leadership Programme's current cohort celebrated its final residential, with recruitment now underway for the next cohort, beginning March 2026.
- Jo and James shared insights on adaptive leadership at the Reach conference.
- CPAS was represented internationally James in Switzerland at the Intercontinental Church Society conference, and Jo in Denmark on the Danish Arrow programme.

 Simon and Matt launched our new Change Course, working with five churches over three months as we explored their local change projects.

Finally, we're thrilled to welcome Marjolein Barrett as our new Leadership Team Administrator.

# Patronage

Since the last Connected, we've been encouraged by 26 licensing services in our Patronage parishes across the country, from the Isle of Wight to the Isle of Man, and from Watford to Wolverhampton.

We've also made a further 25 appointments – we are the sole patron for 16 of them. We thank God for his faithfulness in each of these appointments.

- Since January, team highlights have included the gathering for Evangelical Patrons which we hosted in London for the Evangelical Patrons' Consultative Council (EPCC). It was a hugely encouraging day of input, networking and prayer.
- Rob, one of our Patronage Development Officers (on the left in the picture below), also took the brave decision to jump out a plane at CPAS' first skydive for Venture holidays!

Finally, we were glad to receive this message from a candidate who, despite not being appointed, wrote to express his thanks for our team's advice and encouragement,

Our Venture and Falcon holidays officially kicked off on 23 July and we're so excited and expectant to see what God might do over the summer. At the time of writing, we have **2,339 young people** booked across 46 Venture holidays and **137** booked across ten Falcon holidays.

Emma\* (\*name changed) attended Broads Cruise Venture over Easter and shared this about her experience,

- Joy Langley, our new Falcon Holidays
   Development Officer joined us in July. A
   former headteacher, she brings
   significant experience of working in the
   education and charity sectors. She will
   bring fresh energy to our upcoming
   Falcon review (and plans to visit every
   single Falcon holiday this summer!).
- The last School Venture under the original model ran in June with 35 pupils from St Paul's CE Primary school supported by St Paul's Church, Leamington Spa. We're excited to launch our new School Ministry model in the autumn, as we focus on helping churches and schools' partner together more closely (watch this space).

# From a Life-Changing Venture to a Lifelong Supporter

Clare first heard about CPAS Venture holidays in 2016 through her church youth worker, and she was eager for her daughters to go.

Then aged ten and eight, they attended Woolie 4 Venture. 'They were nervous about getting homesick,' Clare remembers, 'but I was amazed by how gospel-centred it was and how nurturing the leaders were. The girls couldn't wait to go back!'

Inspired by their experience, Clare volunteered as a leader the following year. 'Seeing children, some from disadvantaged backgrounds, begin to open up, trust and ask questions about Jesus was extraordinary. These children might never have encountered the gospel otherwise.'

The Ventures experience impacted Clare's whole family. 'I shared what I'd witnessed with my then non-Christian husband, Tim,' recalls Clare. 'He saw how it impacted the children and me, and it switched a light on for him.'

Despite not being a Christian himself, Tim's heart was moved, so he and Clare began supporting CPAS financially. Just a few years later, Tim came to faith.

Almost ten years later, Clare and Tim give regularly, pray intentionally and champion CPAS' ministry.

'We've witnessed how Ventures make children feel safe, known and loved,' says Clare. 'They discover the truth of who they are in Christ – something the world can't offer. CPAS' work truly bears fruit and brings eternal hope in a messy world. It's a wonderful cause to give towards. You're not just donating – you're investing in eternity.'
