BEGINNING WELL TOGETHER



The beginning of a new incumbent's ministry is an exciting new chapter in the life of the local church. It provides a great opportunity to reflect on the story of all God has done and look forward to the new future God is leading you into over the coming years.

As patron of 700 churches across the country we recognize the significance of starting this new stage of the journey well, equipped and ready for all God has in store. So, we are inviting each of our CPAS patronage churches with a newly appointed incumbent to take part in Beginning Well Together.

What is Beginning Well Together?

Beginning Well Together is a new online course that will explore three distinct and related aspects of leadership we believe are foundational to making the most of the next phase of your journey with God:

- · Leading well with others.
- · Shaping culture.
- Discerning God's direction.

Designed for a group of up to six leaders from your parish or benefice, including the incumbent, the course is delivered within the crucial first year of a new incumbent's ministry. There are three interactive sessions lasting two hours each, containing both input and group work.

Our aim through Beginning Well Together is to make mission possible right from the start of a new incumbent's ministry, equipping church leaders to work well together, shaping a culture for growth and discerning God's direction for God's people in their local contexts.

Throughout the course we will share practical examples for action for each of these three areas including how to apply them to mission and evangelism.
