







# **UPDATE: SUMMER 2021**

Thank you so much for praying for Ventures and Falcons in this turbulent and unpredictable season. We praise God for the extraordinary faithfulness, flexibility and tenacity of our wonderful volunteer leaders who have valiantly planned (and replanned!) a fantastic programme for thousands of 8-18s in the midst of uncertainty.



- Full-length residentials with limited numbers (likely to be around 30 children, depending on government regulations).
- Shorter residentials with limited numbers (e.g. two holidays, each 3-4 days long, enabling twice as many to attend).
- Several residentials with limited numbers running simultaneously on the same site, with no interaction between groups.
- Virtual events similar to those run in 2020, with games, challenges, Bible studies, worship and crafts online.





There are also a number of holidays which have taken the difficult decision to cancel, as none of these options were feasible. Many are sending the young people who would have attended a 'holiday-in-a-box' containing games, children's Christian resources, treats, crafts and messages.

# GOSPEL OPPORTUNITIES

In his second letter, Peter writes (amongst other things) to assure his readers that the apparent tardiness of Jesus' return is part of and within the sovereign plan of God. In short, God is granting as much time as possible for as many people as possible to come to living faith in the Lord Jesus, 'not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance' (2 Peter 3:9).

This of course points us to the good news of the gospel – that in Jesus we are freed from sin and the judgement that is one day to come. This helps us in knowing how to pray since it indicates that it is on God's heart for men, women and children to have the opportunity to find abundant life – both for now and all eternity.

So as our nation walks out of restrictions, and holidays and 'staycations' spring up, let's be praying fervently for our Ventures and Falcons. Of course, the opportunity to respond to the gospel may look very different this year, with some holidays running virtually, through local hubs or in other formats (see previous page). But our prayer remains that children and young people will hear the gospel and discover for themselves the grace that is found in knowing Jesus.

Thank you for standing with us and praying for us. Together, let's make it our business to seek God for his mercy and grace in our nation, and let's share in the urgency of prayer for what Peter wrote about all those years ago.


# **WOOLHAMPTON 1** (11-14s)

- Ask that the local church is also able to engage their young people with the material. Pray also for the leaders as they look ahead to reconnecting in person next year.

#### **Prayer points:**


