LIGHT OUT OF **DARKNESS**

We're delighted to be taking part in the Big Give Christmas Challenge this year (see previous page). Please do consider supporting this campaign to help churches reach young and old with the light of Christ this Christmas.

In Paul's second letter to the Corinthians (4:1-6) he draws on this theme of God's light to point to two realities that must shape and undergird all mission. Firstly, he indicates that the reason people don't perceive and respond to the good news of the gospel is that they have been 'blinded' by the evil one (the 'god of this age', verse 4). Second, he reminds us that since God created light out of darkness in the beginning, he can do the same in the human heart (verse 6).

These words therefore remind us that the growth of the Church is ultimately a spiritual thing. We are not wrong to devise new strategies, new forms of ministry, plant churches or any other activities we feel will contribute to the gospel being taken to every door. But we must not think that these cause the hearts of men, women and children to hear and receive the saving grace of God. That is wonderfully and solely a work of God alone – who causes his Spirit to enable the human heart to see his glory in the person of Jesus.

So, as you join us in praying for the work of CPAS, let me invite you to pray that God will work through the churches, leaders and initiatives described in this update to shine in the darkness of human hearts so that many will come to know Christ.

LEADERSHIP COURSES

PAS has now facilitated sixteen 12-month in-depth leadership courses in partnership with five different dioceses. Courses are currently running in Hereford and Peterborough, with plans in the pipeline for an online version which will be open to clergy across the nation.

HASLEMERE HOLIDAYS



LEADING EVANGELISM LEARNING HUBS


