


# Longing to equip your key leaders to lead communities and congregations?

God is at work. People are stepping up to new leadership responsibilities. They are embarking on an adventure. New territories to explore, new challenges to experience, new opportunities to embrace.

As a Minister or Oversight Minister you want to resource these leaders, to journey with them on the adventure. Our new ground-breaking resource will help you do just that.

# Who Is The Guide For?

Anyone leading a congregation or community who isn't the vicar. Amongst others, that means leaders of:

- **Fresh Expressions** You know the sort of thing, Messy Church, Forest Church, Café Church and so on.
- Church plants Big and small, rural and urban, grafts or new plants.
- New worshipping communities Reaching out to new people in new places and in new ways, forming them into communities with worship at the centre.
- Congregations A midweek service or Sunday afternoon all age congregation.
- Churches A church in a Multi-parish Benefice where the vicar can't
  possibly be present at every service or live within every community.

In many dioceses these people are called **Focal Ministers** (or Focal Leaders, Recognised Local Leaders, Local Ministers or some variation of these). We are using 'Focal Ministers' as a catch all for a wide variety of such leaders.

If they are the **public face** of the church, congregation, fresh expression, or church plant, **known as the leader**, taking responsibility for **developing the mission and ministry** of that community, and **encouraging the gifts and vocations** of all its members, **they're in.** 

# What Does It Involve?

The Guide is an online asynchronous learning experience that combines onsite conversations with you as the leader's Oversight Minister, Network Leader, Minister or mentor.

Understanding the time pressures on many, we have devised a self-directed scheme that fits into daily life, broken down into bite-sized pieces. And we have provided a rich repository of additional resources for those that would like to go deeper.

This approach enables participants to learn at their own pace and at a time that is convenient to them. It is **flexible**, **practical**, **and engaging**. It is also **accessible**, even to those with limited knowledge and confidence with technology.

We provide materials to help participants **contextualise their learning** and to encourage each other as they learn together, as well as **conversation starters** to facilitate discussion with you as their Oversight Minister, Network Leader, Minister or mentor. See the overview on the back page.

Put simply, it provides everything you need to equip your key leaders.

# What Is The Approach?

We have moved away from the traditional language of courses, instead using the metaphor of **exploring a new country**, rich with opportunity to grow and learn and discover.

There are six Regions (equating to six 'courses') on the Island of Leadership which people can select from.

Each Region has multiple sites to visit (see the overview on the back page). In total there is over **22 hours of content**. The learning is mixed-mode, incorporating videos, written materials, exercises, quizzes, case studies, reading and reflection. Everything is rooted in Scripture.

# What Does it Cost?

There are two ways to access The Guide.

# **Diocese or Networks**

For dioceses or networks wanting to provide it for all their Focal Ministers (or equivalent), there is an annual fee dependent on the number of users.

This will include unlimited access, and all online materials.

If you're in a diocese or network that has subscribed this will be the cheapest way to access The Guide. And if they haven't subscribed, let them know about it and invite them to do so.

# Individuals

Individual leaders can purchase a Region at a time for £25, hopefully funded by their church, with a £25 discount if they sign up to all six Regions at the same time (£125).

The production of The Guide is heavily subsidised to enable costs to be kept low for users.




